		sector, focusing on agriculture, irrigation, and power projects to achieve self-sufficiency.
3	С	The "Plan Holiday" refers to the period from 1966 to 1969, after the failure of the Third Plan due to wars and drought, when three separate Annual Plans were implemented instead of a full Five-Year Plan.
4	С	"Garibi Hatao" was the key slogan and objective of the Fifth Five-Year Plan (1974-1979), which aimed to alleviate poverty and achieve self-reliance.
5	С	The Second Plan was based on the Mahalanobis model, developed by the renowned statistician <b>Professor P.C.</b> Mahalanobis, which emphasized investment in heavy industries.
